






#BNC2014

To collect emails for the Written BNC2014 we rely on the generosity of the British public to give us access to their sent emails to incorporate them into the corpus. We are asking the public to provide us with copies of any emails sent between 2014 and 2018. Emails should be unedited, but you are welcome to anonymise them. We will carry out our own anonymization procedures, but if you would like to remove any personal information yourself, please replace it with [anon] before submission.

Note: Emails should be written by British native speakers, people who grew up in the UK and use English as their first language, and unedited.

Step 1: Open any email which was sent by you during the period 2014-2018. Do not submit emails that have been sent to you unless you have received consent from the sender.



Step 2: Copy and paste the text of the email into a Word or .txt file. Repeat this for as many emails as you can (we are looking for 1,600,000 words, so the more you can offer, the better!). Keep personal and professional emails in separate files, and keep emails from different years in separate files.

Step 3: You are welcome to anonymise the data by replacing any names or personal information with **[anon]**. We will carry out our own anonymization procedures, but if you would like to remove personal information yourself, we would recommend sifting through your messages to ensure you are happy for everything to be included in the corpus.
